October 24, 2006 Jesus

TRUSTFUL SURRENDER TO THE DIVINE WILL OF GOD

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TRUSTFUL SURRENDER TO THE DIVINE WILL OF GOD

“Eternal Father, I trust in your loving Will for me.”

February 28, 2007 Eternal Father

“Dear child, no one can fathom the depths of My Divine Will any more than they can fathom My Divine Mercy. But in the same way that Jesus petitions your heart to trust in Divine Mercy, I beg your trust in My Divine Will. Remember, trust is the fruit of love. Therefore, pray for a deep and abiding love of My Divine Will for you.”

“Do not be quick to question circumstances and events of the day, but see My Will in every present moment. Carry in your heart and upon your lips, the ejaculation, ‘Eternal Father, I trust in Your loving Will for me.’ This little prayer carries with it—peace. I send an angel to assist you when you believe.”

“I, your Eternal Father, desire this be made known and be made popular.”

March 2, 2007 Jesus

“Now this is the way to accept the Divine Will of the Father. Surrender yourself completely to Me. I cannot lead you or provide anything for you outside of the Father’s loving Divine Will. Just as Divine Love and Divine Mercy are one, so too, are the Will of My Father and My Will. His Heart is inseparable from My Own Sacred Heart. Therefore, when you abandon your own will for what I desire, you are surrendering to My Father’s Will for you.”

March 3, 2007 Jesus

“The one who trusts in Me is My warrior of love. It is such a one that perseveres amidst every trial no matter its cause or effect. The true warrior of love allows Me to use him as I choose and does not seek his own will in any situation.”

“The surrender of the soul’s free will makes him an apostle of Holy Love, as well as a warrior of love. The apostle works to spread the good news of the message. The warrior fights to defend the message no matter the cost to self, even to the surrender of his will.”

March 5, 2007 Jesus

“Heavenly Father, I desire that You place the Seal of Your Divine Will upon my heart. Thus, I will accept Your Will in all situations and in every present moment. I will accept all things as from Your Hand for the good of my salvation and the salvation of others. Amen.”

“I invite you to have every faith in My Father’s Will for you. His Provision is complete in every present moment. His Will is unending and never fails; therefore, have hope for the future.”

November 6, 2007 Blessed Virgin Mary

“Dear children, I invite all of you to surrender to Me. It is impossible to surrender if you first do not trust, and it is impossible to trust if you do not love. Therefore, My little children, see that I am calling you to trustful surrender through Holy Love. And I am blessing you with My Blessing of Holy Love.”

April 22, 1998 Jesus

“Thank you for coming, believing, and trusting. I invite you to see that any area of fear in your life is a point of entry that Satan is using. Replace the fear with trustful surrender through your own will. Do not give in to thoughts that destroy your peace, arouse anger, or perpetuate fear. Think of My Heart. Think how it is encircled by thorns. These thorns are all the ones who call Me friend, but who do not trust and love Me. When I return, there can be no ‘ifs’ or ‘maybes’ - only ‘Yes, I love’, or ‘No, I choose not to love’. Thus, the soul himself chooses salvation or damnation. Think how important Holy Love is. It is My call, through My Mother, to salvation.”

August 29, 2001 St. Thomas Aquinas

“You question how you achieve this elusive trustful surrender through love. First and foremost, love Jesus with your whole heart. Then accept whatever He sends you in every present moment. This means, dear one, you grow to love the Will of God. When you make plans, if God

sends a different plan, you embrace it, all the while knowing His plan is best for you.”

“Let me show you the opposite of trustful surrender through love. This would be a person who cannot let go of his wants. He sets goals and does not want God to have His say. He cannot give up control and be indifferent as to the outcome of a situation. This way of thinking says to Jesus and the Father: ‘I love my will, not Yours’.”

“Do you see the difference? Trustful surrender through love takes a humble stand—always waiting and watching for God’s Will.”

January 26, 2002 St. Thomas Aquinas

“Heavenly Father, I desire to live in your Divine Will in every present moment by living in Holy Love in thought, word and deed.”

“When I am distracted or tempted, I ask my guardian angel to remind me of the present moment so that I may sanctify each moment through Holy Love. Amen.”

“My sister, this is the whole and the sum of sanctification—trustful surrender to the Divine Will of God in every present moment. In this trust is love. In this surrender is humility. In love, humility and conformity to God’s Will is self-denial.”

“The soul who reaches for sanctity must completely surrender what he wants for what God wants. He puts God in the center of his heart and roots out self. It is impossible for the one who is self-absorbed to reach the heights of this surrender, for he views everything as to how it affects himself. He looks for self-gain in everything. He trusts in himself more than in God, for his love of God is imperfect. His existence revolves around his own welfare and not what God wills for him.”

“The soul who pursues sanctification, however, tries to accept all things as from the Hand of God. He sees God’s Will in every situation. He understands that God is working with him, drawing him into sanctification. Therefore, he does not see God’s Will as a sharp edged sword, but as a blazing beam of light illuminating the path he is called to follow.”

“Inordinate self-love cannot choose Divine Love, for the two conflict just as the flesh opposes the spirit. But this message of the Chambers of the United Hearts calls each one to take off the old and put on the new. This is the essence of sanctity.”

September 25, 2002 St. Thomas Aquinas

“I have come to help you better understand trustful surrender. Once again I remind you, humility and love are the foundation of trust. When you trust, you believe no harm will come to you outside of God’s Will. You understand God’s Will for you is always your salvation. When you surrender to God’s Will, this means you give up your will. So, in trustful surrender you trust that God’s Will is always for your best, and you surrender your wants and opinions concerning the outcome of any situation—that is, you leave it up to God.”

January 10, 2005 Jesus

“My brothers and sisters, please understand that there is very little in each present moment that your free will can control. Indeed, your very next breath must be ordained by the Divine Will of My Eternal Father in order to take place. Your existence is dependent upon His Divine Will. Therefore, understanding this, allow your hearts to be transformed by His Will and you will see that many more graces become apparent in your lives.”

April 25, 2005 Jesus

“My brothers and sisters, the purpose of every present moment in this life is to overcome personal flaws caused by self-love so that you can go deep into My Heart and earn a great place in Paradise. This is why you are given trials, victories, sadness and joy.”

“Now, it is very good to overcome a flaw in your character because you do not wish to spend a longer time in Purgatory, but it is a nobler cause to overcome these flaws for love of Me. Then I fill your heart with the Flame of My Love.”

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
