How does one explain this unique Rosary to those who have never seen, nor have ever heard of, the Rosary of the Unborn (ROU)? How can we describe the wonder on faces of these people who are in awe of tiny plastic babies curled up inside rosary beads shaped like teardrops? We don’t – at first. We watch as they come in and stare and then pick them up and bring them closer to their vision. We watch as they hold and feel the smoothness of the beads, as they touch them between their fingers. They like how it feels and they know there is something that is quite different in ‘the touch’.



Then we tell them - **“This is the Rosary of the Unborn designed by Blessed Mother at Holy Love Ministries. These are Her tears. Each Hail Mary saves one baby from being aborted somewhere around the world.”** That’s all they needed to hear. No long story. Here are some comments we heard, “How and where do I get these Rosaries?; How come I’m just hearing about it?; I have these.; Blessed Mother is on my front door.; My mother would love these.; Mom, can I have one?; I’ll be back. I’m going to the ATM so I can purchase these.; I have these Rosaries, but I want to get more.;



I’m Protestant and I want to get this to my Catholic friend.; I need to tell my friends in Miami about this – we bussed all the way from FL.; I’m from Slovakia and want to take them back to my country.”

The students – oh, the students! We loved the students with their drive and enthusiasm to protect the rights of the unborn. The hotel was full of students. When they saw the Rosary of the Unborn they returned with their friends and said, **“You gotta see this – its soooo cool.”** They couldn’t stay away. If they could not purchase the Rosary we gave their bus group leaders the ROU finger cards which

For the next 3 days we repeated untirelessly the story of the Rosary of the Unborn. We were parched, refreshing ourselves with the enthusiasm of the people who couldn't get enough of Blessed Mother's Rosary of the Unborn.

The best was the chubby little blonde 10-year-old who entered the exhibit hall with her mother. Her face was rosy from the chill of the winter wind and her nose was a little runny. She

was just a little taller than the exhibit table. She wore one of those Swiss hats with the braids on the side. She kept staring at the Rosary. She seemed shy and we could tell she wanted the Rosary. We could also see the pleading in her eyes and eventual disappointment in her face, as she kept looking up at her mother waiting for the OK to get the Rosary. But the mother didn't have her purse so it was out of the question. It was placed on our hearts to give the Rosary to this 10-year-old. We said to her, "Blessed Mother would like you to have this Rosary." And then as kids do, she gave us one of those

The next afternoon the young girl returned to our table, same hat, same rosy cheeks. She wanted to tell us something. Through her shyness she wanted us to know that she already prayed a Rosary on her new beads. We responded with our thank you and said, "Think of all those babies you just saved and how happy you made Blessed Mother." A bigger smile and off she went happy as 'a newborn baby.' ■

St. Joseph Comes on Feast

Pilgrims came from around the world to Maranatha Spring and Shrine for the promised visit of St. Joseph on the crest of his feast day, March 19, 2011. They came from all around the United States. They journeyed from foreign countries such as Panama, Venezuela, Mexico, Canada, Ireland, France and Tahiti. Many were overwhelmed by the beauty and joy that seemed to permeate the air. Several first time pilgrims commented, "The air is so clean and pure"; "I am overwhelmed by the magnitude of peace and joy that I feel inside."

March 19, 2011

Feast of St. Joseph - Midnight Service at the Field of the United Hearts

(This message was given in multiple parts.)

St. Joseph is here and says: "Praise be to Jesus."

"I have come to call the heart of the world back to unity - unity in Holy Love. Holy Love must be the firm foundation of every heart. Any departure from this brings lack of unity - lack of peace such as exists in the world today. Governments will remain in upheaval until such time that this foundation of Holy Love is recognized in hearts and acted upon in the world."

"These days, resources such as oil, are sought after and fought over. But I tell you, the greatest resource - Holy Love in hearts - is not even recognized as important. The result is war, terrorism, natural disasters and moral degeneration. Departure from God's Commandments has become a political choice. In general people do not recognize good as opposed to evil."

"I, as 'Terror of Demons', tell you, Satan does exist and is promoting spiritual apathy."

"As the world observes the destruction and desperate situation in Japan, all must realize that their welfare, even unto their next breath, is dependent upon the Father's Divine Will. Mankind uses the

natural resources of earth to better his human condition. But it is time that he use his spiritual resources to better his relationship with God."

"In this, particularly I speak of the Commandments of Love which comprise Holy Love. God so deems that I be recognized as 'Foster Father of All Humanity'. As such, I must call all of mankind into the Chambers of the United Hearts. This spiritual journey places the soul securely upon the path of salvation - even sanctification. It is in traveling this path that my foster children will discover their peace and security."

"I caution each one of you against doubts which are Satan's weapon. He is very adept in their use and quite unrelenting. But just as the natural disaster in Japan compromised the source of energy there [nuclear power plants], doubts in the journey through the United Hearts compromise the power of your spiritual journey. No one desires this more than Satan himself."

"Once again I tell you, the heart of the world family must recommend itself to Holy Love before there will be a lessening of suffering. Therefore, it is paramount that each heart surrenders to Holy Love; only in this way can change come."

"When you see great cataclysmic events, please understand that you are glimpsing the state of the heart of the world. The need for conversion

is greater than in any time in history. Unless mankind heeds these warnings from Heaven, greater - more profound events will occur. Heed this warning of your loving foster father."

"My brothers and sisters, my dear foster children, allow me to love you, and please love me in return. As your foster father, I desire to protect you and guide you in your every need. I will never abandon you. I am compassionate with your human condition. Have confidence in my intercession."

"I have come especially to thank all of you who are here with expectant faith in your hearts. My hands are filled with favors and I will spread them in your midst tonight, and tomorrow as well."

"Please realize, sadly, that the disastrous events in Japan were one of the triggers of evil that the Holy Mother predicted and warned you about last year. These events would have been greatly mitigated had more souls hastened to their conversion. As it is, the events that have occurred will have long-lasting effects."

"But tonight, my dear foster children, I am embracing you and urging you to have peace in your hearts and with one another, so that every family is secure and the world family is secure."

"Tonight I'm blessing you with my Fatherly Blessing." ■

The Holy Family and Family Unity

If there is one trend that best characterizes the post-modern world today, it is the disunity and breakdown of the traditional family. In some cities in the U.S., the divorce rate has approached nearly 100%. One unnamed large city recently had a divorce rate of 500%: five divorces for every marriage in a year. Cardinal Ouellet, Archbishop of Quebec and Primate of Canada, states in his book, *“Divine Likeness: Toward a Trinitarian Anthropology of the Family”* – “the situation of the family has become precarious in today’s world, and the consequences of breakdown of the family can be measured by the large problems with which we are too familiar in a climate of secularization where:

1) domestic relations become disconnected from marriage, 2) sexuality is disconnected from love and procreation, 3) family is relegated to the sphere of private life.”

As the Holy Father, Pope John Paul II had never tired of repeating during his pontificate: the preservation, and on a large scale, the restoration of the traditional Christian family is necessary for the survival of Christian society. With this in mind, it might be good to look to the Holy Family – Jesus, Mary and Joseph – as the model of family life for the modern world and as the perfect incarnate representation of the Holy Trinity. If we look closely at the Holy Family, as described in the New Testament, we find certain natural and supernatural qualities that all families in today’s divided world desperately need. On July 26, 1995 – Our Lady of Fatima told the visionary Maureen Sweeney-Kyle: **“Everyone is called to holiness through**



Holy Love. *The grace and love of My Heart is never depleted, only time is depleted for those who do not listen and will not love. **To the family I continue My call to be united in Holy Love.** Jesus desires family values be substantiated in hearts according to Holy Love. Families that fail to unite in My Heart disintegrate, for this is how Satan attacks sound reason. The evil one opposes family unity, but through My grace you will remain united.”*

The Holy Family is the prime example of family unity and sanctity, which is described as living the life of the Church within the home (domestic church.) St. John Chrysostom urged all Christians to make each home a “family church,” and, in so doing, sanctify

and unify the family unit. Just how does one live out the Church within the family? The best way is by making Jesus Christ and His teachings in the Messages of Holy Love and the Gospel at the center of both family and individual life. Ways to do this include: reading Scripture, studying the Messages of Holy Love, and praying the rosary daily; – all done together as a family. The name Fr. Patrick Peyton is synonymous with the Family Rosary. From his Rosary Crusades came the well-known slogan, **“The Family That Prays Together Stays Together”**. This is one of the truest slogans ever coined when the prayer is the Holy Rosary. The Family Rosary anchors the family in unity, peace and security. In times of trial and adversity, calling on the maternal help of our Blessed Mother with the gentle rhythm of the Rosary establishes peace and strength.

On May 31, 2008 – Our Lady, as Mary, Refuge of Holy

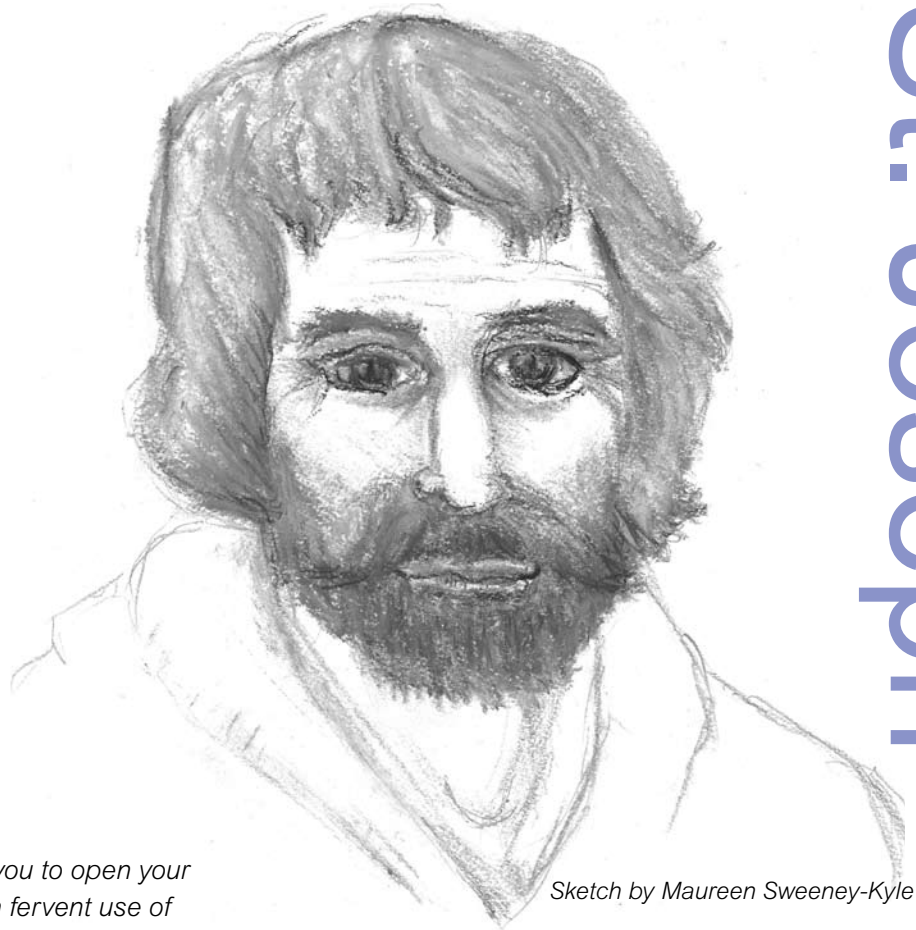

Love, said: *"Tonight I have come to ask you to open your hearts to My Rosary of the Unborn. With fervent use of this weapon, you can save lives and make atonement to Our United Hearts for abortions already committed"...* *"Understand that My Son loves you and desires to be closer to each one of you. Return to prayer. Whole families could be saved through the family rosary. Dear children, you must make holiness more important; prayer and sacrifice your priority."*

On Sept. 5, 2010 – St. Joseph said: **"Families that pray together are at peace; communities that pray together find peace. Whole nations who have in their hearts prayerful attitudes of Holy Love are at peace."** Prayer – especially the *Family Rosary* – brings the remembrance of Holy Love within the Holy Family to the forefront of the modern family; for through the *Family Rosary*, bitterness and discord are resolved; communication is restored and grows; charity at home is inflamed and learns to reach out to others.

On Oct. 3, 2010 – St. Joseph said: *"The heart of the family is the reflection of everything that is in the hearts of each family member. Therefore, every heart should focus upon love of God and neighbor, and every person in the family should live to serve God and neighbor, placing himself last. To do so brings unity in the center of the family."*

The *Family Rosary* is a means of establishing family unity in the heart of the Faith and the Church. On Nov. 7, 2010 – St. Joseph said: *"Thus **united**, you will find the path of TRUTH – the path of LIGHT – which leads to your salvation."* On Dec. 5, 2010 – he said: *"...every family... should be living under the umbrella of Holy Love. In this way they are protected from distractions in personal holiness and obstacles to grace. If they are all living in Holy Love – every member of the family – then Holy Love will be at the heart of the family."*

Through such observations, a Christian family should have God always at the center; and when the family prays and goes to church together, family unity is strengthened. Staying united as a family is important in these latter days when every aspect of family life is attacked. As Pope John Paul II had declared – either we integrate the virtues of the Holy Family or we shall surely disintegrate as a Church and Christian society. A divided Christianity is no match for the enemy who is united. Messages from 2/4, 2/5 of 2000 and 10/31/2001 – on **the Consecration of Families to the United Hearts of Jesus and Mary** – provide the best remedy for family unity in these latter days. ■



Why is Holy Love Ecumenical?

The call to be holy is a universal call to all people and all nations. The call to walk the path of holiness is not exclusive to any one particular group of people and/or religions. The Holy Love Messages are meant for all people and all nations. Heaven is calling all people and all nations to pursue personal holiness through Holy and Divine Love. On February 24, 2008 – Jesus said in a message: “My brothers and sisters, I come to you in this **ecumenical** ministry, as I desire all people and all nations allow their hearts to be transformed through these Messages. It is only through love that mankind can be reconciled with its Creator, not just Catholics, not just Muslims, not just Americans or Chinese, but each soul must be transformed through this Message of Holy and Divine Love. Once your heart is converted, my brothers and sisters, it is your responsibility to be the message in the world.”

Because the Messages are meant for all people and all nations, Holy Love Ministries is an **ecumenical** lay apostolate promoting Christian unity, as Jesus prayed in John 17:20-21.

The following messages provide more clarity to this universal call:

Message of December 19, 2003

St. Thomas Aquinas comes. He says:

“Praise be to Jesus. I have come to help you and all people to realize why these Messages on Holy and Divine Love are indeed **ecumenical**.”

“The heart of the Message—love God above all else and your neighbor as yourself—strikes at the heart of sin. Every sin is a transgression against Holy Love. Sin is not peculiar to one segment of the population. Satan tempts every heart. The soul can only willingly embrace evil when he loves sin more than God and neighbor.”

“At Fatima the peace of the world was entrusted to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Please note this was not the peace of the Catholic world, but the whole world. Since the Immaculate Heart of Mary is Holy Love, understand that the peace of the world has been entrusted to Holy Love.”

“Our Lady is Queen of Heaven and Earth, Queen of the Universe, and Her Immaculate Heart – Holy Love – is beckoning all people, all nations to be reconciled with God and with one another.”

Message of May 25, 2003

Jesus is here with His Heart exposed. He says: “I am your Jesus, born Incarnate.”

“My brothers and sisters, the Immaculate Heart of My Most Holy Mother is the path to salvation and peace. Herein She draws not just Catholics, not just those who believe in the Message, but all people and every nation. This is an **ecumenical** call.”

Message of November 10, 2010

“I am your Jesus, born Incarnate.”

“I tell you in all truth, this Mission has been called into being through the Divine Will of God and exists in and through His Divine Will. We are here

for the welfare of all people and all nations. My call to live in Holy Love is a call to unity in the Divine Will. No one holds jurisdiction over God’s Divine Will except the Eternal Father – the Eternal Now.”

“Once again I state this is an ecumenical call. Our detractors – please note – this means no one has the right, either in canon law or civil law, to claim jurisdiction over Heaven’s Mission here. We exist (I say, ‘we’, for I am part of this Mission) to save souls and to call souls to personal holiness.”

“I invite all to understand that everyone has a right to his good reputation. Those who set about trying to destroy the reputation of anyone need to repent before it is too late; for you know not the hour of your own judgment.”

“So I state once again, good does not oppose good. If you are in opposition to this Mission, you have not been inspired by the Spirit of Truth but by the father of lies. Awaken! Hasten to your conversion!”

“My Mercy awaits you.”

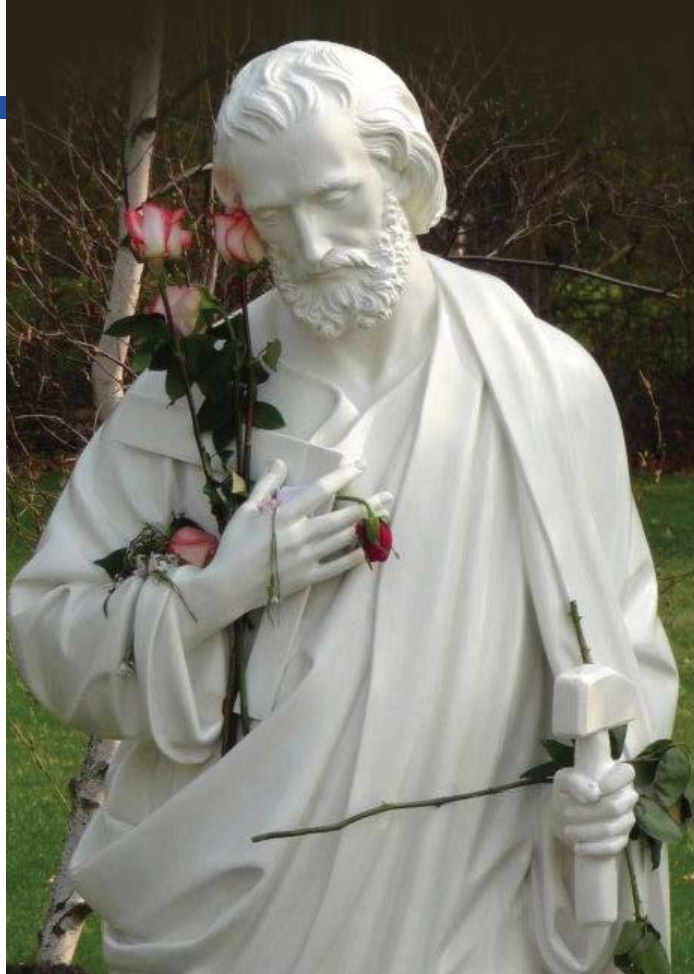
Message of November 13, 2007

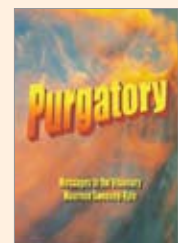

Making the Spiritual Journey Series

Part I

In this section, we begin a series entitled: **“Making the Spiritual Journey.”** This journey is unlike any other journey we have ever made, for it is a *‘mystical’* journey, which God, the Father, invites all peoples and all nations to go on with Him, with the ultimate goal or destination being intimate union with Him; as He is united with His Son, Jesus Christ, through the Holy Spirit. This mystical goal or destination of union with the Holy Trinity is essentially the goal of reaching *Heaven* – also known as establishing the Kingdom of the *Divine Will* within hearts (souls).

The route or road map that we use on this journey is known as *Chambers of the United Hearts of the Holy Trinity and the Immaculate Mary*. The Chambers of the United Hearts are really a *spiritual blueprint or guide* of how we are to progressively *surrender* our free will if we are to move deeper into the Divine Will toward the goal of union with God. Hence, unlike any trip we would make in the world, God tells us that if we are to make this mystical or spiritual journey, we *cannot* bring any baggage with us. In fact, we must leave everything behind – *especially* our free will. If we are to reach union with God and His Divine Will in our hearts, the only vehicle that can take us there is *trustful surrender* of our free will to the Divine Will of God. The Chambers of the United Hearts, then, are really a study of how to give up our will so that we can move *deeper* into the Divine Will and ultimate union and immersion as

one with God. The Chambers of the United Hearts specifically provide the way of *salvation, holiness, perfection and sanctification* needed to reach Heaven – union with the Divine Will.

Making this spiritual journey through the *Chambers of the United Hearts* involves being perfected more and more in holiness so as to: *“be holy, as I, the Lord your God, am Holy”;* **(Lev. 19:1-2)**; and to: *“be perfect as your Heavenly Father is perfect”;* **(Mat. 5:35)**.

In this series, we are going to look at the process of how to progress deeper in this spiritual journey of personal holiness; and what obstacles keep us from progressing upon the path toward our goal of union with the Divine Will. But what exactly is the connection between being holy and our goal of reaching Heaven – *union with the Divine Will*? Typically, we think of holiness in terms of being good, doing good things for others, and avoiding sin. This is not exactly what holiness means, however; for any good person can be good, do good and avoid evil. There are many people who perform good works, but do not pursue personal holiness. What constitutes being holy and perfect, (as God is Holy and Perfect), means conforming our lives and our will to God's Will. The bridge between God's Will and man's free will is *love and mercy*. It is only through God's Divine Love and Divine Mercy that we are offered the opportunity to begin this journey of personal holiness. In a similar way, the soul must open his heart to love God at least a little to begin the journey; otherwise his free will carries him in a whole different direction. The soul must also realize that God's

plan for him may not be what his free will wanted, but that God's plan is perfect and thus worth choosing. Being holy, then, is about perfecting our relationship with God – not about our goodness.

To be holy means that we are to set aside our selfish desires and to make loving God and serving Him, (and then our neighbors), the top priorities of our lives. It means to strive to learn from God how to be gracious and merciful, slow to anger and most loving; **(Psalm 86:15)**. This involves us accepting the gift of humility in order to be conformed to God's Will. Flaws in our humility are always what cause us to slip and fall off the path of holiness that leads into the *Chambers of the United Hearts*. Throughout the spiritual journey of holiness, from the First Chamber to the last, we must pray for humility. It is necessary as we begin this journey that we always distinguish between God's Will and our own free will. God told us what His Will was when He gave Moses the Ten Commandments. Jesus encapsulated the Ten Commandments into the two great Commandments of Love: love God above all else and your neighbor as yourself. This is what Our Lord and Our Lady refer to as *Holy Love*. *Holy Love is the Immaculate Heart of Mary – the First Chamber of the United Hearts*. Holy Love is God's Will for us. It is, then, God's Will that we surrender to Holy Love in every present moment. The amount of Holy Love in our hearts is no small matter, for it is a measure of our perfection in holiness, as Blessed Mother is perfectly holy. The degree of our holiness in the present moment is best expressed in our adherence

to the Ten Commandments and in following Jesus' teachings through His Life, Death and Resurrection; for Jesus' purpose in coming among us as a man was to show us the way toward union with His Heavenly Father, and to bring our hearts to perfection through His *Sacred Heart* that is perfectly in communion with His Father's Heart – the Heart of *Unitive Love*. On March 25, 2008 – Jesus said in a message: *"I come to you today on behalf of My Father Who desires and wills that He be recognized under the title of **Father of Unitive Love**. It is under this title that My Father desires to reconcile all people and every nation by drawing them through the Chambers of Our United Hearts. Oh, how He longs for this union with mankind; how He longs that souls be united in love! This spiritual journey is truth*

itself given through the Light of the Holy Spirit. As I opened the Gates of Heaven for you with My Passion and Death, the Father now opens the door to union with His Divine Will through this spiritual journey."

Jesus' command to us to *"be perfect as your Heavenly Father is perfect"*, (Matt 5:35), is His call to all humanity to follow His way of perfection in holiness through the Chambers of His Sacred Heart, beginning in the *First Chamber*, which is the *Immaculate Heart of Mary*. The perfect example of holiness of the Heart of our Blessed Mother, (*united* to the *Sacred Heart* of Jesus), is the entrance or gateway toward our union with God. It is, then, God's Will that we enter the *Immaculate Heart of Mary* – that we *surrender* to Holy Love – first and foremost and in every present moment.

We were told at Fatima that the peace of the world has been entrusted to the *Immaculate Heart of Mary*. The peace of our hearts and, thus, the peace of the world depends on our *surrender* to Holy Love. As Moses had led the Israelites out of Egypt into the promised land, Blessed Mother now leads her Remnant Faithful children through their trials and tribulations into the peace of the New Jerusalem by taking them into the safe Refuge of Her *Immaculate Heart*. To enter this refuge, however, the soul must seek holiness always. In the next part of this series, we will look at some of the Holy Love Messages which focus on beginning this *journey of personal holiness through the Chambers of the United Hearts*. ■
